NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING
REDISTRICTING OF CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS

The Livermore City Council will conduct a public hearing per California Elections Code Section 21607.1 at its meeting of January 24, at 7:05 p.m., at which time the City Council will 1) receive an update on redistricting efforts to date; 2) conduct a public hearing to receive public input on the composition of City Council voting districts and communities of interest before maps are drafted; and 3) provide initial direction to the demographer on the draft maps to be considered at the third public hearing to be duly noticed.

Resulting from suspension of certain provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act due to a State of Emergency in response to COVID-19, the meeting will be held though videoconferencing beginning at 7:00 p.m. You may access the meeting through YouTube (view only), Zoom or phone call. All interested persons are invited to participate in said hearing and express opinions and comments relating to this matter. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to AB 361. Public comments can be submitted during the meeting over Zoom (verbal comments), or prior to the meeting using e-comment no later than 4:00 p.m. (on website) or emailing cityclerk@cityoflivermore.net no later than 12:00 p.m. on January 24, 2022. Comments may also be submitted to the City Clerk at 1052 S Livermore Avenue, Livermore, CA 94550 and by email at redistricting@cityoflivermore.net no later than 12:00 p.m.

Simultaneous Spanish interpretation will be provided during the public hearing. Please contact the City Clerk's Office at (925) 960-4200 or via email at redistricting@cityoflivermore.net if live interpretation in another applicable language is needed for this hearing or if a reasonable accommodation in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act is needed. Notification 72 hours prior to the meeting will enable the City to make reasonable arrangements.
